Governor General's Medal	- graduating student with highest average in Grade 11 & 12
Thomas A. Stewart Scholarship Foundation	- graduating student proceeding to post-secondary with highest average
Trent University Second Decade	- graduating student proceeding to university with highest average in 6 12U or M
Trent University Excellence in Science Award	- graduating student proceeding to university with highest average in 2 12 U courses from Math/Biology/Chemistry/Physics (at least 1 science)
University Women's Club Award-Olive Langley Award	- female graduate with high academic standing proceeding directly to post secondary who demonstrates citizenship through involvement in school or community and/or volunteer service who has financial need
Angela & Katrina Blackburn Memorial School Dedication Award	- graduating student who has displayed a consistent commitment to academic excellence and has participated in extra-curricular activities including sports and/or music
Rob Brown Award	- graduating student who has displayed citizenship, congeniality and team spirit, and extra-curricular involvement
Chartwells Community Recognition Award	- graduating student who has made a significant contribution to the community
Chartwells Scholarship Award	- positive contribution to the school environment
Corporate Express Scholarship	-highest average in 2 business courses, the first being college/university Grade 12 Mathematics, and the second being one of either Grade 12 Economics, Accounting or Law.

Lieutenant Governor's Community Volunteer Award for Students	- exemplary student involvement in the community
McColl Turner Award	-outstanding achievement in accounting
Gerry Middleton Memorial Award	-graduating student who has excelled in technical courses throughout his/her education
Olive Isaac Award	-student who has shown most skill and creativity in flower arranging and/or plant propagation
Ontario Youth Apprenticeship Program Commencement Award	-deserving Coop student who has participated in a Cooperative Education placement in an apprenticeable trade -planning on pursuing a career in the Skilled trades -does not need to be registered as apprentice -student in final year
OSSTF	graduating student who has demonstrated exemplary citizenship & consistent commitment to education
Paquette Family Award	-student who excels in the sciences who is going on to post-secondary education in either the sciences or in a health-care related field, who is not necessarily the recipient of other awards
Peter DeCarlo Memorial Bursary	-graduating student proceeding to apprenticeship or post-secondary in technology or the trades -student has overcome adversity
Peterborough Chamber of Commerce Award	- the Co-op student each semester who best exemplifies the qualities of teamwork, dedication, perseverance and good human relations skills

W. Ross Pinkerton Memorial Scholarship	-must be resident of Peterborough or Northumberland proceeding to college or university -deserving student who may have contributed to the school or community or who may have been involved in a number of extra curricular activities
Principal's Award	- graduating student who has made an outstanding contribution to the school
TAS Bursaries	- deserving graduates proceeding to post-secondary education
TAS Staff Bursary	- deserving graduate proceeding to post-secondary education
Valedictorian	- nominated by students; selection by awards committee
Women's Art Association of Canada, Peterborough Branch	- graduating student with the top mark in a Gr 12 Art, Music or Drama course (alternative years 2006 Art, 2007 Music, 2008 Drama)

Blackbourn Memorial Jazz Award	plaque	- senior music student who displays enthusiasm and excellence in music studies
